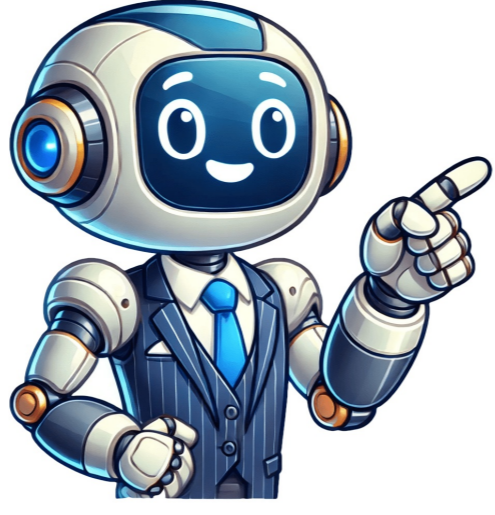

The first will be the ascent of the very famous Coll de Rates, 6.7 kilometers at 5.2%, where every winter some of the world's best test their form.But the race should be decided afterwards on the much more difficult Alto de Turron Duro, 3.5 kilometers long at 9% with it's summit only 9.5 kilometers away from the finish - half of them downhill. El CICLISMO DE ATAQUE SE CITA EN LA 41ª CLÁSICA CV 1969 El tríplico valenciano de inicio de temporada se cuenta con la 41ª edición de la Clásica Comunitat Valenciana 1969 este domingo. La prueba unirá Valencia y La Nucia a lo largo de 184 kilómetros donde los ciclistas más atacantes tendrán la oportunidad este año de romper el pelotón para llevarse la victoria final. Participación de lujo El pelotón contará con un gran nivel de ciclistas que verán en las montañas valencianas la oportunidad de conseguir su primera victoria de la temporada. Entre los grandes nombres de la lista provisional se encuentran: las estrellas internacionales Michael Matthews (Team Jayco AlUla) y Matej Mohoric y Santiago Buitrago del Bahrain Victorious; los españoles de Movistar Team, Iván Remeo, Gonzalo Serrano o Jon Barrenetxea; el ganador de etapa en La Vuelta, Urko Berrade (Equipo Kern Pharma); Filippo Baroncini, Jan Christen, Antonio Morgado o el joven talento español Marcos Freire con el UAE Team Emirates. También actuarán en la salida desde La Nucia corredores de la talla del Alex Aranburu (Cofidis), actual campeón de España. La representación valenciana será de 4 ciclistas: Joan Bop y Jaume Guardieño (Caja Rural-Seguro RGA), Víctor Martínez (Sabgal/Anicolor) y Gonzalo Ariño (Illes Balears-Arabay). Un total de 22 equipos formarán el pelotón de la Clásica CV 1969, de ellos hasta 8 de categoría UCI World Team. Como suele ser habitual el perfil de la etapa invita a una bonita fuga inicial y el control de los equipos que pretenden acabar al sprint. Sin embargo, este año los atacantes en la parte final tendrán mucho que decir. El añadido del Alt del Canonge-La Nucia (conocido como Turron Duro) abre las esperanzas de que quienes logran la victoria en solitario o en un grupo reducido. Tras salir de Valencia y recorrer el reconocido tramo de llano, el pelotón afrontará tres puertos puntuables. El primero será el Alt de Barx (3ª categoría - 6 km al 5,6%) en La Safor, más tarde el mítico Coll de Rates (2ª categoría - 6,6 km al 5,3%) y como novedad de la edición, se subirá el Alt del Canonge-La Nucia (conocido como Turron Duro) a 9 km de meta, un muro de 3,5 km con desniveles de más del 18% y una media del 9,9%. Tras coronar, una espectacular bajada hasta La Nucia dará final a la edición.
Horarios El Passegj de la Alameda en la ciudad de Valencia verá partir al pelotón, el domingo 26 de enero, a las 12.15 horas. Una hora antes, desde las 11.15h, tendrá lugar la presentación de equipos con el control de firmas.
