## Oklahoma career guide

OKCareerGuide.org offers free online career planning tools for Oklahoma residents. Launched in 2015, this statewide system is designed specifically for the state and provides a wide range of resources, including: - Career awareness development - Individualized career plans - Online portfolios - Assessments to explore careers and post-secondary schools - Scholarship information - Resume and cover letter building - Connecting with businesses and industry Users can access these tools at no cost through the OK Career Guide system. To get started, visit and set up your account to explore available resources and tools, such as the Kuder Career Interests Assessment, Skills Confidence Assessment, and Super Work Values Inventory. Students can view their assessment results on the "My Assessment Results" page under "My Assessments". The results are grouped by career fields and clusters, with 16 nationally recognized career clusters. OKCareerGuide has organized these into 6 career fields, making it easier to recognize them.
