Set inside the anecdotal Liberty City (in view of New York City), the single-player story follows a war veteran, Niko Bellic. Grand Theft Auto IV is an action-adventure game that portrays a dark and realistic world where players can drive under the influence of liquor and experience viciousness. The game's successor, Grand Theft Auto V, was released in September 2013. The game is set in Liberty City, consisting of three main islands, and allows players to freely roam the open world as Niko Bellic, the protagonist. Body armor can be used to absorb gunshots and explosive damage but is consumed in the process. Players will interact with new characters throughout the story, many of whom they will form friendships with, and these characters will execute favors for Niko when requested. The game also features morality choices that alter the narrative based on the player's choice. Players can participate in context-specific activities such as bowling or darts while exploring the game universe. The smartphone is used to access the game's online multiplayer mode and enter cheat codes. To access the in-game internet, players must use Internet cafés located around the city, allowing Niko to send and receive emails and put up potential dates with girlfriends. The game also features a more extensive subway system, permitting rapid traversal throughout the game's world. The internet multiplayer mode for Grand Theft Auto IV allows up to 32 players to float throughout a recreation of the world. Players can choose from various game modes, including deathmatches and road races, with two combined and aggressive options available. The game features ranked and unranked matches, requiring players to earn in-game money to accelerate through positions. A Free Mode is also available, where players have unrestricted access to the map without any objectives or missions. Game hosts can control various factors, including police presence, traffic, and even weapons. The Windows version offers a LAN service. Set in 2008, Grand Theft Auto IV takes place in a redesigned Liberty City, focusing on four boroughs of New York City: Broker, Duker, Bohan, and Algonquin. The game's storyline follows Niko Bellic, an Eastern European immigrant who arrives in Liberty City to reunite with his uncle Roman. However, he discovers that Roman's stories of wealth and luxury were lies, and they live in a struggling cab business. The situation escalates, leading to a firefight between Niko, Roman, and Dimitri's associates. Niko's life takes a dramatic turn when Roman is kidnapped by Dimitri's men in an attempt to lure Niko out. Meanwhile, Michelle reveals herself as Karen, a government representative who tries to recruit Niko for United Liberty Paper, offering him a chance to clear his criminal record and help uncover the traitor within the unit. Niko agrees, taking on various assassination missions for the agency. Roman's fortunes also improve when he receives a large insurance payout, allowing him to buy an apartment and restart his taxi business. He even proposes to Mallorie, who accepts. As Niko becomes embroiled in Liberty City's underworld, he befriends Patrick McReary, a small-time Irish mobster, and assists Ray Boccino with a major diamond deal that goes awry. Later, Niko is forced to kill Ray on the orders of Don Jimmy Pegorino. Eventually, United Liberty Paper tracks down Darko Brevic, the man responsible for Niko's unit's desperation, bringing him to Liberty City for Niko to settle his past. Niko must now decide whether to work with Dimitri or exact revenge. If he chooses the former, Dimitri betrays him once again. If he goes for revenge, Roman is accidentally killed by an assassin sent by Dimitri at his own wedding. Niko then kills Dimitri and Pegorino in separate confrontations. In the end, Niko's journey concludes with a dramatic showdown that sees him exacting revenge on those who have wronged him. Rockstar's Grand Theft Auto IV marked a significant shift in the series' design and tone, embracing high-definition graphics and a more realistic approach. The game's setting, Liberty City, was meticulously crafted using SpeedTree for foliage, while the developers aimed to create a seamless environment with minimal dead spaces. To achieve this, the Rockstar North team conducted extensive research in New York, making two trips to gather insights on the city's layout, architecture, and cultural nuances. By abandoning cinematic influences and focusing on realism, the game's director Dan Houser emphasized the importance of authenticity in video games as they evolve. It is essential to reference actual areas rather than other stuff. Houser stated that they wanted something unique for the character, moving away from obvious references to pictures. The team aimed to create music that embodied New York City's essence without feeling dated upon the game's release. Ivan Pavlovich explained that they needed to select songs that would accurately represent the city at that time. To achieve this, Rockstar contacted over 2,000 individuals to obtain publishing and recording rights, including a private investigator to find Sean Delaney's family members to license their song "Walk the Night". The team paid up to \$10,000 per track for composition and master tape rights. DJ Green Lantern created tracks specifically for the game's hip-hop radio station, while Bobby Konders flew to Jamaica to record dancehall music. Grand Theft Auto IV was initially released for both PlayStation 3 and Xbox 360. During an April 2008 meeting, Take-Two CEO Ben Feder announced that the game had "gone gold" and was in final production stages. The game involved a large team of over 1,000 people and had a budget estimated at around \$100 million, making it one of the most expensive games ever created at the time. A Microsoft Windows Edition was later announced in August 2008, along with plans for release on November 18, 2008, in North America and December 2-3, 2008, in Europe. The game featured expanded features, including improved traffic density control, draw distance configurations, and a replay editor. The game allowed players to record and edit gameplay clips, which could be uploaded to Rockstar's Social Club website. It utilized Games for Windows – Live for internet play and supported up to 32 gamers in multiplayer mode. However, the game required a one-time online activation and utilized SecuROM security. The game was made available on Steam on January 4, 2009. Later, due to issues with generating new keys using Games for Windows – Live, Rockstar temporarily removed the game from Steam in January 2020. The Grand Theft Auto IV: Complete Edition was released on March 19, 2020, which included the base game and episodic content.
