The Seditious Act is passed by the U.S. Congress. The Bastille, a fortress in Paris used to hold political prisoners, is stormed by a mob. France and Portugal sign the Treaty of Lyons, aligning themselves against Spain. Joan of Arc, taken prisoner by the Burgundians in May, is handed over to Pierre Cauchon, the bishop of Beauvais. In France, Louis VIII succeeds his father, Philip Augustus. Humanity made its "giant leap" onto the surface of another world on July 21, 1969.Outstanding baseball pitcher Gaylord Perry's manager mocked his batting ability in 1963, joking that "There would be a man on the moon before Gaylord Perry would hit a home run."Joseph Walker became the first US civilian to go to space on July 19, 1963.US Air Force pilot Jeremiah Denton was shot down and taken prisoner during the Vietnam War on July 18, 1965.A grand jury indicted Wayne B Williams for the murder of two men in Atlanta, Georgia, on July 17, 1981.Chinese Premier Mao Zedong swam across the Yangtze River in Wuhan on July 17, 1966, a move that marked the beginning of one of the bloodiest periods in modern history.Police have said the motive for the shooting of designer Gianni Versace outside his Miami Beach mansion may never be known.A truck smashed into a crowd of people commemorating Bastille Day in Nice, France, on July 14, 2016.Mass murderer Richard Speck stabbed or strangled eight student nurses in one night on July 13, 1966.Three identical triplets born on July 12, 1961, were separated at birth and given to three different families.More than 120 people were killed in a plane fire that started with a cigarette on July 11, 1973.Despite 46 people witnessing the murder, nobody has ever been charged.Andy Warhol premiered one of the most controversial, baffling and famous exhibitions on July 9, 1962.The US military did declare they were in possession of parts of a "flying disc", but retracted the claim within a day.Eccentric tycoon Howard Hughes was nearly killed piloting prototype reconnaissance aircraft XF-11 on July 7, 1946.Francis Goodell hijacked a Pacific Southwest Airlines flight from Oakland to Sacramento on July 6 in 1972.Disney released the adventure film Napoleon and Samantha on July 5, 1972.The world's third richest man disappeared during a flight across the English channel on July 4, 1928.Rolling Stones guitarist Brian Jones was found motionless at the bottom of his swimming pool on July 3, 1969.Soccer player Andres Escobar was gunned down on a street on July 2, 1994, just days after he scored an own goal that cost his country a game in the FIFA World Cup.On July 1, 1963, the British government handed over the former colony of Hong Kong - marking the end of an empire.A heroes' welcome awaited three history-making cosmonauts - then rescuers pried open their shuttle.The Beatles touched down in Brisbane to a sea of adoring fans. But a small group in the back got up to no good. Archduke Franz Ferdinand had already survived one would-be assassin that day. His luck did not last.Eight people were killed when a refrigerated truck released sarin gas on a residential street in Matsumoto, Japan, on June 27, 1994.The unofficial leader of the Soviet Union was toppled in a party coup on June 26, 1953.US park ranger Roy Sullivan was struck by lightning while fishing in a pool on June 25, 1977.The deputy prime minister took the nation by surprise when she made a bid to oust Kevin Rudd from the top job in 2010.The Palace Hotel in Childers, Queensland, became the scene of an unimaginable tragedy early on June 23, 2000.The live-action Disney film Treasure Island was released for the first time on June 22, 1950.Nearly three years to the day after discovering a hollow nickel containing a coded spy message, the FBI arrested their suspect on June 21, 1957.When Spielberg's blockbuster opened in cinemas, it was a box office success. But many who saw it never left the sand again.Maximilian I, the Emperor of Mexico, was executed by firing squad in Queretaro on June 19, 1867.At the behest of the world's largest banana company, the United States launched a coup d'etat on the government of Guatemala on June 18, 1954.An entire city ground to a halt on the evening of June 17, 1994, and people around the country tuned in to watch Los Angeles police chase a white Ford Bronco in a low-speed pursuit.Rudolf Nureyev was one of the Soviet Union's biggest cultural exports - but he was making them nervous. A teenager shot and nearly killed a star baseball player in a Chicago hotel room just after midnight on June 15, 1949.Fed up with rabbits on his private estate in France, bacteriologist Paul-Flix Armand-Deuille infected two of them with the myxoma virus on June 14, 1952.The Daily Mirror published a photo of spiritualist Colin Evans apparently levitating in a room full of people on June 13, 1937.Former dictator of the Central African Republic Jean-Bedel Bokassa was found guilty of at least 20 counts of murder on June 12, 1987.An unemployed former ice cream van driver was accused of cheating after winning big on a game show that aired on June 11, 1984.The poisoning case involving a debarain socialist and his heiress wife grabbed global attention.Decades on, the families of the seven victims are searching for answers amid claims of corruption and cover-ups.Minutes after declaring his intention to live to 100, organic food advocate Ji Rodale died on stage during a taping of The Dick Cavett Show on June 8, 1971.An episode of children's television show Mr Rogers' Neighbourhood took the highly unusual step of explaining a confronting adult issue on June 7, 1968.The young naval officer went onto famously yield a light sabre as a Jedi master in the hit films.Many patients with the deadly disease were received with indifference or outright hostility.
