The 2025 Fifa Club World Cup is set to kick off in the United States on Saturday under a new format. The tournament will now take place once every four years instead of annually, and it has been revamped to feature 32 teams from six international football confederations: AFC, Caf, Concacaf, Conmebol, OFC, and Uefa. Teams from each confederation have qualified based on their performance in the equivalent of Uefa's Champions League over the past four seasons. The European teams, including recent winners Chelsea and Manchester City, will feature 12 places, which are decided by clubs' performances over the four-year qualifying period. The Austrian side Red Bull Salzburg will also be present, having qualified through being the highest-ranked club across the past four Champions League seasons from a country that does not already have its two spots occupied. The United States has been awarded an extra place as hosts, and six places are reserved for South American clubs, with one spot going to Oceania. The teams will be divided into six groups, with each group featuring teams from different confederations. The maiden edition of the new-look Club World Cup will feature clubs from 20 different countries, including seven European teams. The revamped Club World Cup will feature 32 teams divided into eight groups of four, with each team playing the others once in a round-robin format. The top two teams from each group will then proceed to the knockout stages, without a third-place play-off. The final match is scheduled for July 13, 2025, and carries a 775m prize pot, with the winner earning up to 97m. Clubs participating in the tournament will receive a set amount for each round, increasing significantly as the competition progresses. European clubs will earn more than those from other continents, with the highest ranked teams receiving 29.6m and the lowest 9.9m. The matches will be held in 12 different stadiums across the United States, a year before the country co-hosts the 2026 World Cup with Canada and Mexico. The opening match is set to take place in Miami, while the final is scheduled for New Jersey. A deal worth \$1bn (787m) has been struck between Dazn and FIFA to secure exclusive global rights to the tournament, which will be broadcast live on Channel 5 in the UK. However, this agreement has raised concerns due to a recent stake sale of Dazn to Saudi Arabian firm Surj Sports. FIFA is facing criticism over the scheduling of the tournament, with several players and leagues expressing concerns about player wellbeing amid an increasingly packed football calendar. The final countdown to the Club World Cup comes at a time when the international match calendar for 2025-2030 was approved by the FIFA Council in 2023. Manchester City and Chelsea to face Al-Hilal and Benfica in Club World Cup's last 16, while Inter Miami and Palmeiras await PSG and Botafogo respectively in knockout stages after group stage conclusion.
