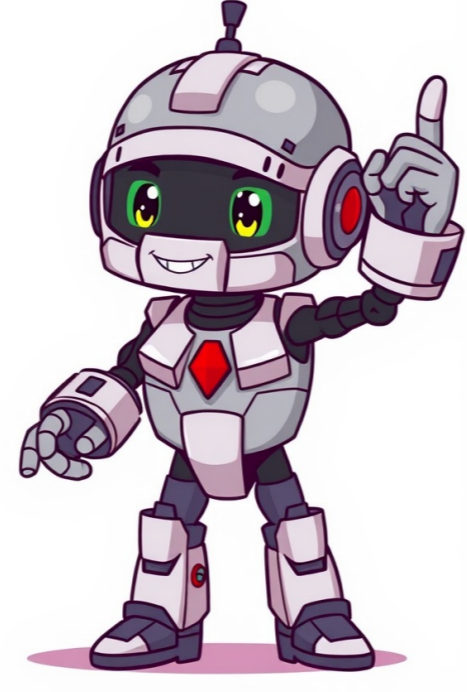

Hi all, I've been using duckduckgo lite as a primary search engine on my main profile. On other profiles I've mostly been using searXNG. Problem is, searXNG isn't good for sophisticated results. Most search engines I've used yield wildly different results. I was fine with using duckduckgo lite as from what I've gathered is still the second best search engine after brave search. Duckduckgo how ever does engage in (minor) censorship, and the straw that broke the camels back was when duckduckgo started feeding me microsoft ads. I know they ddg has been riding microsoft's meat for while now but this is just too far. Startpage is good for results, but is still limited by what google decides to show. This can be good and bad, as google does censor certain topics. It also isn't on-par with other private search engines, in terms of privacy. From what I understood, it censors Tor ip's and collect (anonymous?) analytical data. Then there is MetaGer. I enjoy MetaGer, but, it has ads. These ads are... not subtle. For example when I search "trees", I get 3 different ads at the top of the search results. I am in the process of setting up a pi-hole, but this is still very, very annoying. An very positive aspect of MetaGer is that it has a built in proxy available, which is very unique. Brave search seemingly has the best of both worlds, it is fully independent and recently fully removed any ties to bing and microsoft, unlike ddg. However, I am concerned about their experiments with brave ads. Although this should not necessarily be a problem if I have a adblocker or pi-hole. It also does not seem like Brave collects any "analytical" data. However, they do get a strike on the board for being closed-source. Honorable mentions to Mojeek, Qwant & Ecosia, but they are not what I'm looking for. Thoughts? Page 2 Hola a todos, He estado usando DuckDuckGo Lite como buscador principal en mi perfil principal. En otros perfiles, he usado mayormente SearXNG. El problema es que SearXNG no es bueno para resultados sofisticados. La mayoría de los buscadores que he usado dan resultados muy diferentes. Estaba bien usando DuckDuckGo Lite porque, por lo que he averiguado, siguió siendo el segundo mejor buscador después de Brave Search. Sin embargo, DuckDuckGo sí hace censura (menor), y la gota que rebasa el vaso fue cuando DuckDuckGo empezó a mostrarme anuncios de Microsoft. S que DDG le ha estado haciendo la barba a Microsoft desde hace un tiempo, pero esto ya es demasiado. Startpage es bueno para resultados, pero no está limitado por lo que Google decide mostrar. Esto puede ser bueno y malo, ya que Google censura ciertos temas. Tampoco está a la par de otros buscadores privados en términos de privacidad. Por lo que entiendo, censura IPs de Tor y recopila datos analíticos (anónimos?). Luego está MetaGer. Me gusta MetaGer, pero tiene anuncios. Esos anuncios no son nada sutiles. Por ejemplo, cuando busco "árboles", me salen 3 anuncios diferentes en la parte superior de los resultados de búsqueda. Estoy en proceso de configurar un Pi-hole, pero esto sigue siendo muy, muy molesto. Un aspecto muy positivo de MetaGer es que tiene un proxy integrado, lo cual es muy nice. Brave Search aparentemente tiene lo mejor de dos mundos: es totalmente independiente y recientemente eliminó por completo cualquier vínculo con Bing y Microsoft, a diferencia de DDG. Sin embargo, me preocupan sus experimentos con anuncios de Brave. Aunque esto no debería ser necesariamente un problema si tengo un bloqueador de anuncios o un Pi-hole. Tampoco parece que Brave recopile ningún dato "analítico". Sin embargo, se lleva un punto en contra por ser de código cerrado. Menciones honoríficas a Mojeek, Qwant & Ecosia, pero no son lo que busco. Opiniones? I'm using Brave, but once I missed a letter and write l instead of k, i automatically redirected to a virussite, and it started to download the virus without my permission, so my trust dropped a lot. I'm thinking of changing, and I've seen a lot of good comment of Duckduckgo's browser. Anyone using it or what do you think about it? I read an article on techcrunch (link below) that says soon to be launched Brave search is the only real privacy focused search engine built from ground up. I use duckduckgo as my primary search option and was fairly confident about the privacy. However, seeing this article, I am less unclear as to what brave search has that duckduckgo doesn't? Or is it just another marketing stunt? Anyone who can provide some context would be helpful.
