How to Tell When Your Watch Needs to be Serviced I recommend that no matter if your watch shows signs of needing service, you get it serviced every 3 to 5 years regardless. When it comes to my luxury watches I ask for proof of their previous work and ask them to email me pictures. Always expect some parts will need to be changed. A Service will include a full inspection of the parts for potential repairs since there will be wear when metal is acting on metal. If you have a high-end luxury watch, please use good judgment. I'm often asked if you can service, your watch yourself. If your watch isn't under warranty, you don't have a valid proof of warranty, or you are not the original owner, it may make more sense to visit a local shop. My recommendation is to always let a pro technician do their job. Here are a few warning signs that your watch may need to be professionally serviced: Watch Has Completely Stopped: A Quartz watch contains complex gears that need to work together simultaneously for functionality. Some folks consider changing the battery in a quartz watch every 3 years as a routine servicing. The only DIY I would seriously consider is a deep cleaning of a waterproof watch. Authorized Service Center: These tend to be specialized horologists and master craftsmen who will deal exclusively in your brand of watch. It's also possible the stem snapped inside and it's affecting the movement. Watch Repair Shop: Typically they are generalists who are familiar with popular brands and models. Contact Professionals: If you're unsure about any step or if the watch seems to have a complex issue, always contact a professional. It's recommended you replace the battery every 1 to 3 years. They have the right tools, expertise, and team to handle intricate repairs. This gives you an idea of the pricing and prevents unexpected costs. If you use an authorized service center that may replace parts as a matter of protocol even if a part didn't need replacement. Ensure you purchase the right batteries for your watch model. After a while, you may feel the crown is either hard to turn or so loose that you can't adjust the time and date. They will likely have seen your specific model before and be familiar with the mechanics of other watches from the same time period of the same manufacturer. Handle the battery with care and avoid touching it with your fingers to prevent corrosion. They may be certified and qualified to service your watch, but you should understand the risk if you should ever want to make a claim. A service center is often a place that has an online web form you fill out and mail in with your watch. Having your watch serviced by anyone or a company that is not authorized will void your warranty if you are still under coverage. Jewelry Store: Typically these are also generalists, but with a bit more experience on the luxury watch end. A Breitling, Omega, or Rolex is \$500 and up as a starting point. If the time seems wrong or inconsistent, it might need professional calibration. Cost will vary depending on the level of service, brand, and age of the watch. Gaining or losing a significant amount of time each day is indicative of a movement fault. Strap and Bracelet Adjustment: Adjusting the range of the strap or bracelet can be done using simple tools. Watch Doesn't Keep Correct Time (Leading or Lagging): A Quartz watch is known for keeping accurate time, while mechanical movements lose a few minutes a day, especially in a vintage model. The authorized service center will provide the most qualified master craftsmen for your brand. Often they will air on the side of caution because they want to ensure they get paid for their work and second to ensure they don't do anything that may decrease the value of the watch in the eyes of a collector. Then you can compare the price and options. The Second-Hand Jumps at 5-Second Intervals: The second-hand jumping is often a low battery power indicator in a Quartz watch. The downside is all of this will come at a premium price. How Much Will it Cost? Even if the place near doesn't do servicing they can recommend someone who can. This includes disassembly, cleaning, and reassembly with new parts as needed. A standard low-level watch might run \$50 for a simple service, while a mid-level watch like a nice Seiko may start around \$300. Don't risk damaging your watch by wearing it in water without proper testing!Regular cleaning and maintenance is crucial for the longevity of your watch. Resources for Watch Service Near Me Sometimes it's good to get some help from the watch community. This also means damage to the case, bracelet, gasket or crown. If your watch stops ticking, it might be time for a battery replacement. When a watch battery is left completely drained inside a Quartz watch can leak which will cause damage to the movement. The Crown is Difficult For Time or Date Adjustments: The crown is attached to a stem, which connects to your internal watch movement components. Likely your routine servicing is not a process covered by warranty, but having them perform the work will keep your warranty in place. Moisture inside the glass is a sign that the seals have corroded or the watch wasn't resealed correctly. Additionally, I visit their websites and read both reviews and customer testimonials. It requires an expert level of skill as it requires taking your watch apart and inspecting the movement. Especially if you have a high-end luxury timepiece. In that case, you would need an expert repair. Also, there are a few brands like Cartier, that don't use service centers instead they use their sales boutiques as service centers. For example, a repair shop or jeweler might be open 24 to 48 hours, while a service center could be a month. These repairs will cost extra. Test the Watch Accuracy: After performing any service, always test the watch's accuracy over a day or two. I would be hesitant to refer to them as horologists or master craftsmen, mostly because anything complicated they will send out for servicing. Find out prices, time frame, what's included in the service, guarantees, and qualifications for my brand of watch. I always advise you to call around a bit. Again I wouldn't qualify these as horologists or master craftsmen, because anything complicated they will mail to an expert. If left unserviced can cause more damage to the movement and may stop working completely. Can I service My Watch Myself? This is particularly true for high end luxury watches. You can actually have them do it even if it's not under warranty. What is recommended is every 3 to 5 years a full movement overhaul including full disassembly, a complete cleaning and re-oiling (lubrication) of the parts, reassembly of the movement, and improvement in the timing. For context one of my blog readers reported that they just had their 38-year-old Rolex 1680 Submariner serviced for \$1,200, which required some repairs. It may be a movement fault or a battery issue. The time will vary based on the level of service you need, the amount of customers in the queue, and the business you choose to do the work. I would advise shopping around locally and contacting your watch brand's authorized service center. The Watch Glass Has Moisture Under It: Moisture and/or Chemicals are highly damaging to all movement types because they lead to rust inside, which requires a major overhaul. However, be cautious not to scratch or damage the watch in the process. If you have replaced the battery and the watch still doesn't work it's likely related to a movement problem. A full servicing on a luxury watch is not something you should attempt to do yourself. On the plus side, this is usually a more economical servicing The advantage of going to a local shop is dealing with a person directly and the cost is cheaper. Don't let any of these issues linger. You may also see your alarm or digital display has stopped. A service center is typically significantly longer because of the amount of work they receive. Many service centers, as protocol replace parts automatically, regardless of whether or not they need replacing. Then someone contacts you with a quote for the work. All of that will additionally be impacted by any repairs or replacement parts you may need. I never advise you to do that, but if that interests you, read this DIY service article here.
