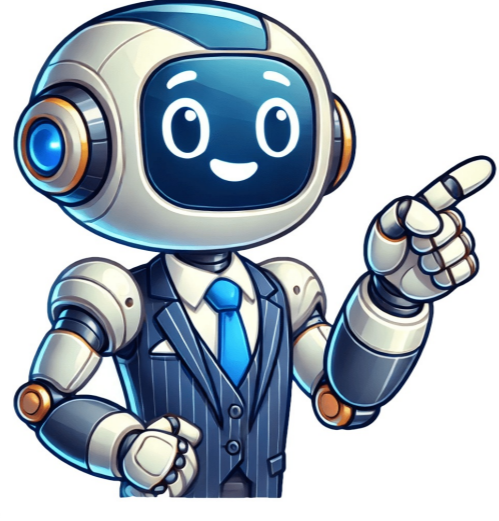

The Electronic Federal Tax Payment System tax payment service is provided free by the U.S. Department of the Treasury. After you've enrolled and received your credentials, you can pay any tax due to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) using this system. Notice to Website Users - Multifactor Authentication (MFA): Please note:Your tax payment is due regardless of this Web site's availability. You can always make a tax payment by calling our voice response system at 1.800.555.3453. Follow the prompts to make your payment. What You Need to Know The IRS continues to remind taxpayers to watch out for email schemes. Taxpayers will only receive an email from EFTPS if they have opted in for email notifications when they sign up for email through EFTPS. Report all unsolicited email claiming to be from the IRS or an IRS-related function to phishing@irs.gov. You must be enrolled to use the EFTPS tax payment service. To enroll, click on Enrollment at the top of this page and follow the steps. If this is your first time enrolling in EFTPS, your information will need to be validated with the IRS. After this process is complete you will receive a personal identification number (PIN) via U.S. Mail in five to seven business days at your IRS address of record. Payments using this Web site or our voice response system must be scheduled by 8 p.m. ET the day before the due date to be received timely by the IRS. The funds will move out of your banking account on the date you select for settlement. This EFTPS tax payment service Web site supports Microsoft EDGE for Windows, Google Chrome for Windows and Mozilla Firefox for Windows. You may use this Web site and our voice response system (1.800.555.3453) interchangeably to make payments. If you are required to make deposits electronically but do not wish to use the EFTPS tax payment service yourself, ask your financial institution about ACH Credit or same-day wire payments, or consult a tax professional or payroll provider about making payments for you. Please note: These options may result in fees from the providers. Payments through third parties may have earlier cutoff times; please check with them for their deadlines. The Electronic Federal Tax Payment System (EFTPS) is a free tax payment system designed with all taxpayers in mind. This can be used instead of the Electronic Funds Withdrawal (EFW) if you would prefer to set up your payment(s) separately from filing your return. Using the EFTPS system is an easy way to pay your federal taxes for individuals as well as businesses. Make ALL of your federal tax payments including Federal Tax Deposits (FTDs), installment agreements, and estimated tax payments using Electronic Federal Tax Payment System. To make estimated tax payments online, you will need to establish an account at the EFTPS website. Once you have an account established at that site, you can schedule automatic withdrawals for your quarterly estimated taxes, specifying the amounts and the dates of the payments. The EFTPS payment information does not get transmitted when you e-file. You would need to indicate that you are paying by check and then arrange payment through EFTPS. For estimated tax purposes, the year is divided into four payment periods. Each period has a specific payment due date. If you do not pay enough tax by the due date of each of the payment periods, you may be charged a penalty even if you are due a refund when you file your income tax return. Your first estimated tax payment is usually due the 15th of April. You may pay the entire year's estimated tax at that time, or you may pay your estimated tax in four payments. Generally, the four payments are due April 15th, June 15th, September 15, and January 15th of the following year. If the due date for making an estimated tax payment falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the payment will be on time if you make it on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. EFTPS allows tax payments to move electronically from the taxpayer's bank account to the federal government's account. The taxpayer's records with the IRS are automatically updated for each such payment. For further information and to learn about the benefits of using EFTPS, visit the IRS webpage on EFTPS. Follow the steps in the Registration and enrollment details section to register as a filer. Get an authorization from each taxpayer for whom you'll submit enrollments and make federal tax deposits. Enroll each of those taxpayers with the appropriate financial agent. If you want to participate in the EFTPS Batch Filer program, we strongly encourage that you read the Department of Treasury's Batch Provider User's Manual, which you can download from or request from EFTPS customer service. The first step to getting started with EFTPS is to visit the IRS EFTPS web page to download and install the batch provider software. This will guide you through both the batch filer registration process and the taxpayer enrollment process. The software is also used when transmitting the enrollment and payment files. After you've registered, you'll receive an EFTPS registration number and master inquiry PIN to use when you make enrollments and payments using the Batch Filer software. A Batch Filer who is not the actual taxpayer (which is typically the case) is considered to be a Reporting Agent. A Reporting Agent is an accounting service, bank, or other entity authorized to make federal tax deposit payments and submit information electronically for the taxes deposited and reported on Forms 940, 941/944, 945, and other returns on behalf of a taxpayer. As the Batch Filer, you must receive the taxpayer's authorization using IRS Reporting Agent Authorization Form 8655 before submitting that taxpayer's enrollment to EFTPS. You will need to send Form 8655 to the IRS for every enrollment you submit. For copies of Form 8655, contact the IRS or request Form 8655 online at . For legal representatives, Power of Attorney Form 2848 is required. EFTPS is a free system offered by the U.S. Department of Treasury to pay your federal taxes.
