Many institutions in the US require the TEAS as a prerequisite for their nursing program, so students are encouraged to learn more about the institution's eligibility requirements. The TEAS Science exam has 50 questions. This section contains six "pretest" questions that are not calculated with your final score. Test-takers have 60 minutes to complete all 50 questions on the Science section of the TEAS. Yes, at the beginning of the exam, a proctor will provide test-takers with a four-function calculator. Students are not allowed to use calculators with special functions. Finding out the nursing program's score requirements is important. With the TEAS, there is no pass-fail score. You will receive a total or "main" score which includes the individual scores from all four sections (Science, Reading, Mathematics, and English & Language Arts). You will also receive the separate scores for each section. Typically, a program requires you to earn a score of at least 60% to 70%. But, it is highly competitive to gain admission into a nursing program, so students are encouraged to aim for higher than the program's requirements.
